IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR VACATION CARE



The Wilston Kids Care Vacation Care experience is designed to provide your child with a fun and engaging opportunity where they can enjoy their school holidays and learn along the way. Vacation Care offers your child a variety of opportunities to develop social skills, build relationships and engage in experiences unique to Outside School Hours Care.

During Vacation Care the children have the ability to engage in multi-age play during the day. Siblings can choose to play with one another if they wish. Senior and junior spaces will be allocated exclusively for children who would prefer to engage with children of their own age. The Vacation Care Program is designed to cater for all children's developmental abilities, and interests and is child focused to cater for an array of ages from Prep to Grade 6 (4-12 yrs.).

Sun Safety Reminders

The Service has a strict Sun Safe Policy which must be adhered to whilst at care.

Staff and children are required to wear sun safe broad brimmed hats that protect their face, neck and ears.

When outdoors, staff and children will wear sun safe clothing that covers as much of the skin as possible (especially the shoulders, back and stomach).

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

- Midriff, crop, singlet tops or sleeveless dresses that don't provide enough sun protection and therefore are not permitted.
- Baseball caps or visors do not provide enough sun protection and therefore are not permitted. Please ensure your child wears a brimmed hat.

Sunscreen is supplied at the Service and is applied throughout each session. We strongly encourage parents to apply to their child upon arrival or before they attend Wilston Kids Care.

Mealtimes during Vacation Care

At Wilston Kids Care we encourage a healthy lifestyle by engaging children in physical activities and discussions around nutrition.

Breakfast (6:45am - 8:00am) and Lunch (only) are provided at Vacation Care each day. Families are required to supply their child's morning and afternoon tea. Please provide sufficient portion sizes as children are very active in their learning during the Vacation Care Program.

What to bring to Vacation Care

- Closed in shoes (No sandals, thongs or wheelie shoes)
- Spare clothes (No singlets)
- Sufficient Morning and Afternoon tea sized portions
- Broad Brimmed Hat (No Caps)
- Individual Water bottle

Please make sure all these items are labelled

Excursion/Swimming Permission Forms

- All children must have a Vacation Care Permission form completed before the end of Term 4, 2020
- Children are to arrive 30minutes before the bus departure time on the day of the Excursion
- All children are to ensure they have the appropriate clothing and shoes to participate in the Excursion or swimming day

RISK MINIMISATION MEASURES IN PLACE FOR COVID-19 WHEN ATTENDING WILSTON KIDS CARE



- Anyone (staff and children) who is sick with influenza-like symptoms, even with mild symptoms, **must not attend** Vacation Care. This measure protects everyone on site. If we suspect your child is unwell or has a temperature, they will be sent home immediately.
- If a child or staff member becomes ill while they are at Wilston Kids Care, they will be sent home as soon as possible. While awaiting collection by their carer, ideally, the symptomatic child will be cared for in an area that is separated from other children at the Service. This is to prevent the spread of respiratory viruses. Pick up must be prompt to ensure the health and safety of the remaining children and staff.
- Enhance hygiene practices for staff, children and visitors are in place. Washing hands frequently is the single most effective way to reduce the spread of germs that cause respiratory disease. Alcohol-based hand gel is a suitable alternative. Please sanitise your hands before using the Kiosks and upon entry to the Service.
- Social distancing measures will be in place during all talk times and mealtimes. We will ensure smaller groups of children are spread out across the campus in various areas for play times.
- We will ensure robust infection control and cleaning and routine environmental cleaning procedures are in place and are occurring regularly throughout the day.
- Parent Lounge has been temporarily relocated to the stage area to ensure effective social distancing practices are in place. Parents must now sign in and out in this new area to reduce the amount of close contact traffic coming in and out of the small office space.

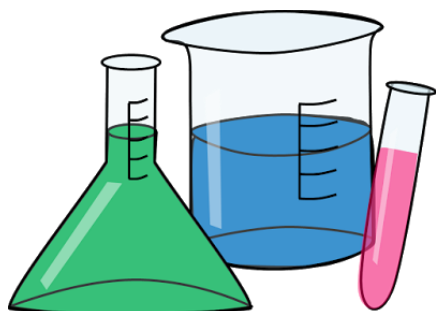

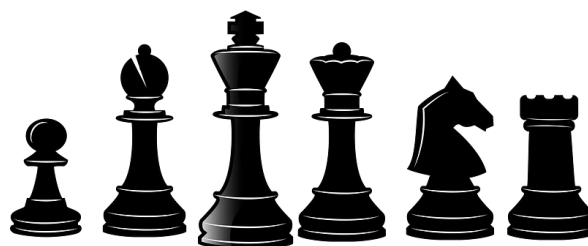
